What are Non-Traceable Components?

Commonly known as 'Surplus', non-traceable components are just that. It includes parts that do not have lot traceability, with various date codes and manufacturers.

Why am I offered Non-Traceable?

If we cannot source the part for you, or you require the part on a shorter lead time, we have an extensive warehouse dedicated to non-traceable parts. These are shipped next day and are often cheaper than purchasing new.

How old is the stock?

We have stock often old as 1 - 2 years to 10 + years.

How do I search for non-traceable stock on the website?

Non-Traceable Stock is identified with a 'Non-Traceable' tag.

Disclaimer

Whenever Servo & Electronic Sales Ltd supply 'Non-Traceable' (also known as Non Lot Traceability on our paperwork) components, the following statement applies.

'Non-Traceable' stock by definition cannot be traced back to the original manufacturer and does not come with any paperwork or other record, electronic or otherwise, of when and how the part was made or inspected after manufacture. For this reason any 'non-traceable' parts are supplied as Product Class B Non Lot Traceability on our certificates of conformity. It is therefore not recommended that 'non-traceable' stock is used on aircraft or other potentially hazardous applications where traceability is normally required.

For this reason any 'Non-Traceable' items sold by Servo & Electronic Sales Ltd is supplied on the basis that traceability cannot be given & no liability can be accepted by incorrect use of such parts.
